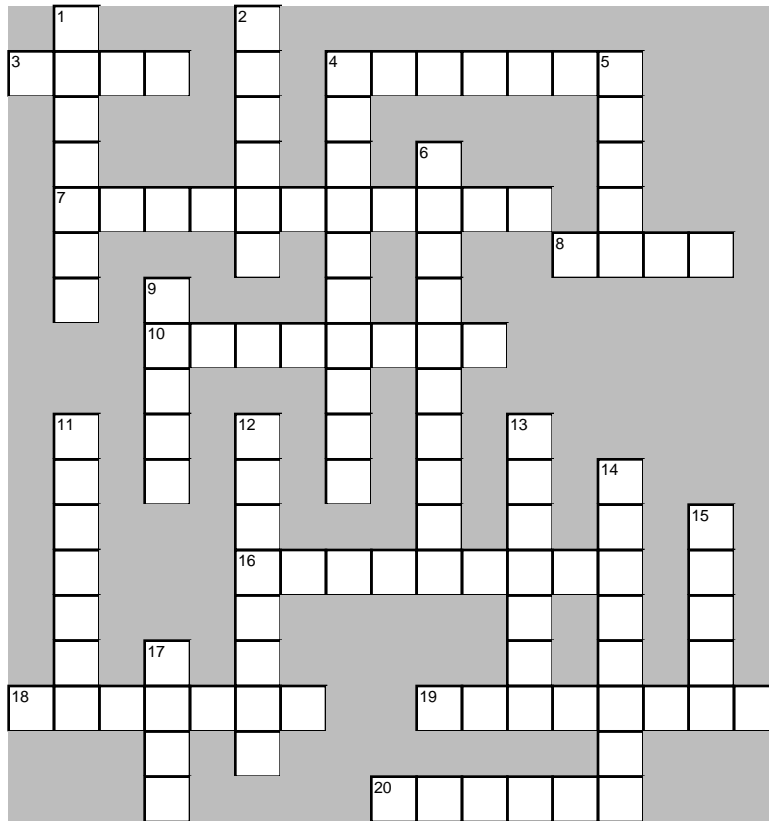


# 4th Sunday of Lent
